Chairman Curns called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Notification of this meeting was given to the Press on April 1, 2023 and the final agenda was posted in the three designated places on April 8, 2023.

Roll call of Officers: Jim Curns, Chairman – Present; Lee Shaw, Supervisor 1 – Present; Matt Manske, Supervisor 2 – Arrived Late - Present; Sandy Jensen, Treasurer – Present; Jeannette Zielinski, Clerk – Present.

All Meetings/Hearings will adhere to Robert's Rules of Order Pursuant to Town of Mukwa Ordinance 10-05.

Approve: March 14, 2023 Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes: Motion was made by Supervisor Shaw with a second by Chairman Curns to approve the March 14, 2023 Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes as printed. Motion carried.

Treasurer: Approve Monthly Treasurer's Report: Read by Treasurer Jensen. Motion was made by Supervisor Shaw and seconded by Chairman Curns to accept the March 31, 2023 Treasurer's Report as read & printed. Motion carried.

Budget/Vouchers: Approval & Payment of Vouchers: Motion was made by Chairman Curns to approve payment of Vouchers 29218 through 29254, dated March 15, 2023 through April 11, 2023 & Direct Withdrawals of Social Security, Medicare & Federal Tax of \$1,776.54; the March 22nd We Energies Invoice of \$1,049.48; & Wisconsin Quarterly Withholding of \$400.93, for a total of **\$49,877.80**. Second to Chairman Curn's motion was made by Supervisor Shaw and the motion carried.

Public Forum - Town of Mukwa Residents: Several residents & property owners were present to talk to the Board about the property, on the river at the end of Ferry Street – in the past the property owner allowed people to launch their boats, but this year it is chained off. The Board explained that it was private property & the property owner is free to do as they want. Noting that this has always been private & is not a public access.

Jim St. Marie – Sunrise Court vented frustration over snow plowing, his road did not get plowed several times. Chairman Curns explained that the County Highway Department plows his road & they had a new person who missed the road & that Mr. St. Marie was correct the road should not have been missed & he should not have to call.

ORDINANCE ACCEPTING DETACHMENT OF LANDS FROM THE CITY OF NEW LONDON TO THE TOWN OF MUKWA (Diem Property)

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Mukwa

Waupaca County

The Town of Mukwa hereby ordains as follows:

That, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 66.0227 the Town of Mukwa in Waupaca County does hereby accept the detachment of the following described territory from the City of New London, Waupaca County, Wisconsin. A copy of the survey plat is hereby attached hereto and made part of thereof by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that the following described Property is detached from the City of New London and is attached to the Town of Mukwa.

Current Legal Description of Attached Property:

Lot 1 of Certified Survey Map #5545 located in part of the Southeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ and part of the Southwest ¼ of the Southeast ¼, all in Section 14, Township 22 North, Range 14 East, City of New London, Waupaca County, Wisconsin.

Containing: 1.03 Acres

Current Population: 3 Persons

WHEREAS, it appears in the best interests of the City of New London and the Town of Mukwa that the afore described City of New London territory be detached from the City of New London and attached to the Town of Mukwa.

This Ordinance shall be in Full Force and Effective from and after the Date of its Town Board Passage and Official Notice per § 60.80.


